### REMEMBER to SAVE your RECEIPTS

Minnesota has two programs - the K-12 education subtraction and the K-12 education credit - designed to help families pay expenses related to their child's education. Both programs lower the tax you must pay and might provide a larger refund when you file your Minnesota individual tax return. But you must have documentation in the form of receipts to prove any specific qualifying expense. So, keep those education expense receipts in a safe place until tax time.
