

Saving/Downloading Movies

Some thoughts, hints, ideas

**SAVE MOVIES TO--->Hard Drive->Users-->Shared-->Your Name
(NOT YOUR DESKTOP OR DOCUMENTS)**

Change your Firefox preferences to ask where to save downloads.

Add the Firefox Add on Called Download Helper to your Firefox menu bar.

Open FireFox

Go to <https://addons.mozilla.org/en-US/firefox/>

(Or search for Mozilla Add ons)

Find the FireFox add on

It's installed when you see this icon at the top



When ever a site with a movie in it is displayed, the icon becomes animated.

Click on the icon and choose download. Direct the movie to your Users/Shared folder.

Use MPEG Streamclip to convert the movie to Quick Time



Use iMovie to trim/clip/edit etc.

Share/export out of iMovie to Quick Time

Other options include:

KeepVid, Zamzar, Online-Convert, iDesktoptv

These work by converting it and saving it for you or emailing you a converted version.
