

Yellow	Priority 2 Needs – (3-10 Years) LTFM annual allocation Building Exterior, Parking Lots, Roofing, Interior Finishes, Mechanical/Electrical, Energy Efficiency				
Green	Priority 3 Needs – (10 + Years) LTFM annual allocation Building Exterior, Parking Lots, Roofing, Interior Finishes, Mechanical/Electrical				

Total Investment: \$6.6 M from LTFM \* No New Tax Impact



#### **Total K-12 Enrollment History**




### **Open Enrollment**

- 8/20/18
  - » School board resolution passed limiting and closing open enrollment.
- 1/28/19
  - » Annual resolution renewed for the 19-20 school year.
  - » District is projecting 50 fewer students in the district for the 19-20 school year.








\* Open Enrollment Policy was changed 8/20/18. This change is projected to result in a decrease of non-resident students.





### Pleasantview Elementary New Site Diagram

- Building capacity: 797 students
- Total building size: 107,595 SF
  - Assumed two story
- Total parking shown: | 50 stalls
- Current Pleasantview parking needs: 133 stalls
  - 118 Staff, 15 visitors
- Bus parking shown: 13 buses
- Playground and hard surface play approx. same size as current
- Existing Pleasantview outline shown for reference
- Site-plan allows for future expansion if needed





### **Pleasantview Elementary**

### • Action:

- » New 797 student building on current site

### • Budget: Estimated Cost: \$36,500,000

- » Budget takes into account construction of new elementary, site improvements (including rerouting utilities) and demolition of existing Pleasantview facility.
- Funding Source:
  - » Bond Referendum (tax impact)







On Tuesday, November 5, the residents of Sauk Rapids and Rice will decide whether to replace Pleasantview Elementary as the first step in the district's long-term facilities plan.

#### THE SINGLE BALLOT QUESTION ASKS FOR \$37.1 MILLION. FOR THE OWNER OF A MEDIAN VALUE HOME IN THE DISTRICT - \$182,000 – THE TAX IMPACT WOULD BE \$6.58 A MONTH.
