- 2. **Concentrated Instruction**: Curriculum is developed based on identified essential learning. Personalized learning paths are developed in order for each student to attain a high level of mastery.
- 3. **Convergent Assessment**: The systemic use of data to determine each student's learning needs and monitor the effectiveness of instruction in meeting those needs.
- 4. **Certain Access**: There is an articulated process that guarantees each student the support and time they need to learn at high levels.
